

Vacancies on your website

Recruit Studio is an in-house database system based on MS SQL Server. All the programs are .Net v2.0 based. Vacancy details in the database can easily be sent to a web site using a web service that we supply, meaning that you can advertise and update your current vacancies on your website directly from Recruit Studio.

Recruit Studio sends vacancy details to a web site using an XML web service invoked from a Recruit Studio client. The web service creates and maintains a file on the web site with a list of vacancies. We then use an ASPX page to present the web user with options for selecting jobs which in turn selects jobs from the vacancies file and presents summary details to the user.

Both the web service and the ASPX page need a Microsoft server running .Net 2.0. This means that your web hosting company needs to be hosting your site on a Microsoft server with Microsoft .NET framework 2.0 running. Most web hosting companies will put you on a Linux server by default which will not work with this facility so you firstly need to check with your web hosting company that you are on/can migrate to a Microsoft server.

Typically you would have a link button on the home page with 'Current Jobs' (or similar) which invokes the ASPX page.

Although you will need to use our supplied web service (to get the vacancies onto the site), you don't need to use our ASPX page which is fairly basic. You can of course create your own ASPX or script driven page(s). They would typically allow the user to specify jobs according to criteria such as sector and location and salary offered, you would then read the vacancies file (which is actually a serialized .Net dataset) to select appropriate jobs and display in a manner you prefer.

There will be some work needed to set up the permissions settings on the individual files that are involved so you need to be confident that your web developer can help you with this. We will upload to your site all the files that you need but because of the many different server configuration approaches (and because lots of web hosting companies will not do this in a very easy manner), we don't typically get involved beyond uploading the files and showing you how to use the facility in Recruit Studio.
